

Based on 2017 provisional data, strengths in this SRIB region include:

Phonics (% achieving)

• A mostly positive and improving picture across all five LA areas: strong improvements in Bristol, which is now in line with the national average, and South Gloucestershire, which is now above the national average.

KS1

• Improvements across all five LA areas this year – with strong performance in N Somerset, Somerset, and BANES, and particularly so in South Gloucestershire, where there were the largest pp gains in all KS1 subjects, apart from Science

KS2 performance (% achieving expected standard RWM)

• Performance across the country increased by 7pp. Similar gains were seen in majority of LAs in this sub-region, with strong performance in BANES.

KS4 performance (P8, A8, 9-5 pass and 9-4 pass)

• Overall progress and attainment in BANES, but... not much else.

SRIB Region A Priorities

Based on 2017 provisional data, priorities in this SRIB region include:

Phonics (% achieving)

• Somerset's 2017 result (79%) was amongst the lowest in SW. Somerset and BANES still below national averages.

KS1 performance

• Bristol is behind other LAs within this sub-region with marked gaps across all subject areas compared to national performance.

KS2 performance (% achieving expected standard RWM)

• Maintaining strong gains into this year across all LAs, and at LA-level, improving performance in North Somerset. At subject-level, mathematics is below national in all but BANES.

KS4 performance (P8, A8, 9-5 pass and 9-4 pass)

• Overall progress and attainment are the key issues. Progress in English is variable, and often weaker than mathematics (this is particularly true in BANES) and wide variation in open slot; mathematics attainment generally the weakest element



- Improvements in phonics seen between 2016 & 2017 in most SW LAs


Priorities

- KS1 an issue for for Bristol
- Phonics is an identified priority for the region, although the SW is now performing at the same level as England nationally
- North Somerset had a small 1pp decline in phonics between 2016 & 2017 (but remains above regional & national figs) - this decline can be attributed to the phonics results for girls

SRIB Region A Attainment Overview – KS2

Strengths

- There have been increases in KS2 ES RWM between 2016 and 2017 across all SW LAs
- There have been increases between 2016 & 2017 across all SW LAs
- Only three SW LAs are above the 61% England average, one of which is BANES, which has clear KS2 subject strengths
- Strong reading attainment in S Glos





Priorities


- The SW (60%) is still below the Eng average (61%) for the expected standard (ES) in RWM but improved more (8pp) between 2016 and 2017 than England as a whole (7pp)
- North Somerset, which was one of the highest performing SW LAs in 2016, has not increased their ES RWM metric as much as others and is now the second-lowest ranked SW LA
- Stagnant attainment in North Somerset needs to be addressed
- For attainment at a higher standard, maths is the focus, particularly for Somerset & North Somerset.

P8 Strengths

- Progress in BANES just below national, and above SW. Still a negative score, however.
- BANES is performing well in most of the progress elements (apart from English progress)
- Maths is a key regional priority, but in progress terms at least, it is one of the stronger elements in this sub-region, particularly in BANES & North Somerset

A8 Strengths

- Attainment above national in BANES
- The Open & Ebacc elements of A8 are relatively strong, particularly in BANES & Somerset
- North Somerset is performing above regional and England averages for their English & Maths elements

P8 Priorities

- South Glos has one of the lowest 2017 P8 scores within the SW
- Both the English & open elements are priorities for this sub-region, particularly English in BANES & the Open elements in Bristol, North Somerset & South Glos

A8 Priorities

- South Glos & Bristol are amongst the LAs with the lowest overall A8 score within the SW (Bristol's A8 data is below other sub-regional performance as is South Glos' results in the Open & Ebacc elements)
- Maths attainment markedly lower than English (BANES excepted)
