## Juvenile Enforcement Procedure Fixed Penalty Notice

The above named juvenile has been identified as committing the offence of "Notice\_Contra\_Long\_Desc" in the location of "Notice\_Issue\_Location" ("Notice\_Area\_Name"), on "Notice\_Contravention\_Date" at "Notice\_Contravention\_Time", by "Notice\_PA\_IC" an authorised officer of North Somerset Council.

North Somerset Council understands that at the time of the offence, «Offender\_Title» «Offender\_ForeName» «Offender\_Surname», was under the age of 18 years.

In accordance with our Juvenile Enforcement Procedure, we now enclose a Fixed Penalty Notice which is an opportunity for the matter to be dealt with without going to court.

Should «Offender\_Title» «Offender\_ForeName» «Offender\_Surname» choose to pay the fixed penalty, the fee of £75 is due within 14 days of receiving this notice. This amount is reduced to £50 if paid within 10 days of receiving this notice.

The 14 day period will commence on the second working date after posting. A working day excludes a Saturday, a Sunday, New Year's Day, Good Friday, Christmas Day and any other English bank holiday'

An alternative to the fixed penalty notice is the option of a restorative justice litter pick session. This session is for a period of up to 3 hours and attendance of the whole session is required. If you agree to this as an alternative option to paying the fixed penalty notice then the whole session must be attended. Failure to attend the session or only part




attendance will mean that the fixed penalty notice will still be valid and payment will be expected. Failure to pay the fixed penalty notice amount may result in prosecution.

Should you decide that «Offender\_Title» «Offender\_ForeName» «Offender\_Surname» is to proceed with the litter pick session instead of paying the fixed penalty then please complete the restorative justice form and return to us within 14 days of the receipt of this letter.


