LSC Application for the Grant of a Club Premises Certificate under the

Sioux Isherwood, Principal Environmental Protection & Licensing Officer, for the Director of Public Health presented the Report and responded to questions. The applicant then spoke to the Sub-Committee and responded to questions.

Avon and Somerset Police Licensing has asked for the following conditions to be added and the applicant has agreed:

- 1. A challenge 25 age related policy.
- 2. CCTV will be fitted to cover the lounge area of the building and the licensed area between the front of the building and the security fence. This CCTV will be of a standard satisfactory to the Licensing Authority and Police. Images will be stored for a minimum of 31 days and made available on request for evidential purposes.
- 3. Non-standard times to be between 1000 and 2300 hours for a maximum of 20 occasions in any calendar year.

These conditions that have been attached to the licence are necessary to promote the Licensing Objectives under the Licensing Act 2003, namely The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, Public Safety, and Public Nuisance.

Resolved: that the Sub-Committee decided to grant the application with the modifications to the conditions as put forward by the Police and agreed to by the applicant.
