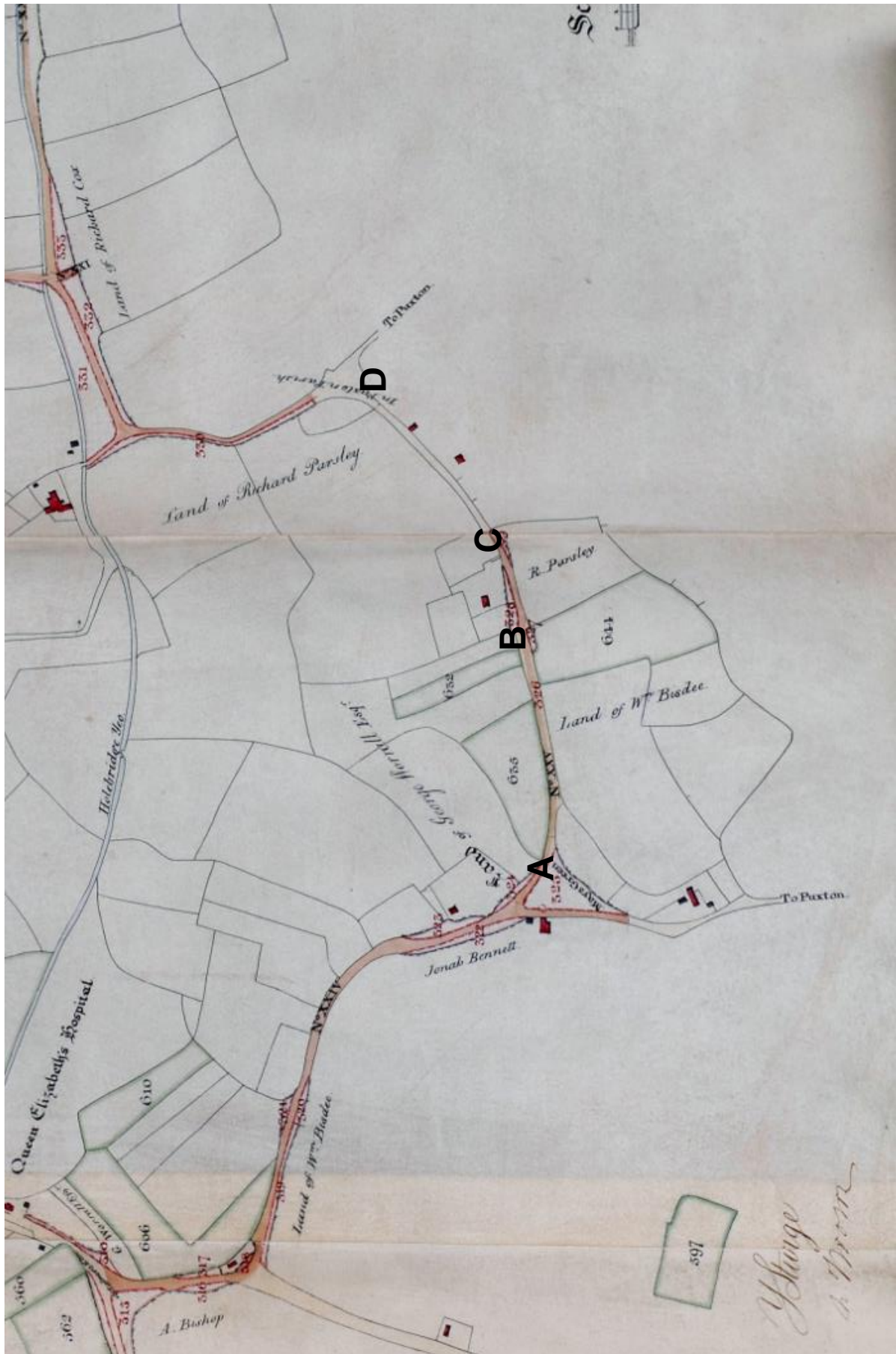

Congresbury, Wick St Lawrence & Puxton Enclosure Award 1809 – Plan C



Goosey Way Drive — One other private Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of twenty feet extending from a certain place called Old Bridges over Goosey Way by the side of the Old Bridge Yeo to a certain Road called the Puxton Road called Goosey Way Drive and numbered ^{XVI} on the said plan C.

Cox's Drive — One other private Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of sixteen feet extending from Goosey Way Drive to an old Inclosure belonging to George Cox called Cox's Drive and numbered ^{XVII} on the said Plan C.

Puxton Road — One other Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of twenty four feet extending from the Public Road or Highway leading from Congresbury to Horle or near the North east Corner of an Allotment hereinafter set out to the said John Pigot in its ancient and usual direction through Old Inclosures to Goosey Way through which it continues also in its ancient and usual direction to the boundary of the Parish of Congresbury adjoining the Parish of Puxton called the Puxton Road and numbered ^{XVIII} on the said Plan C.

Macy's Drive — One other private Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of twenty feet extending from the aforesaid Public Road or Highway leading from Congresbury to Horle near a certain Garden belonging to ^{XIX} towards Goosey Way aforesaid called Macy's Drive and numbered ^{XIX} on the said Plan C.

Puxton Drive — One other Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of twenty four feet extending from the Road leading from Congresbury to Wick Saint Lawrence at a place called Palmer's Ebn towards Puxton called Puxton Drive and numbered ^{XX} on the said plan C.

Bennetts Drive — One other private Carriage Road or Drive of the breadth of twenty feet extending from the said last mentioned Road or Drive over Mays Green to an ancient Lane leading towards Goosey Way aforesaid called Bennetts Drive and numbered ^{XXI} on the said Plan C.
