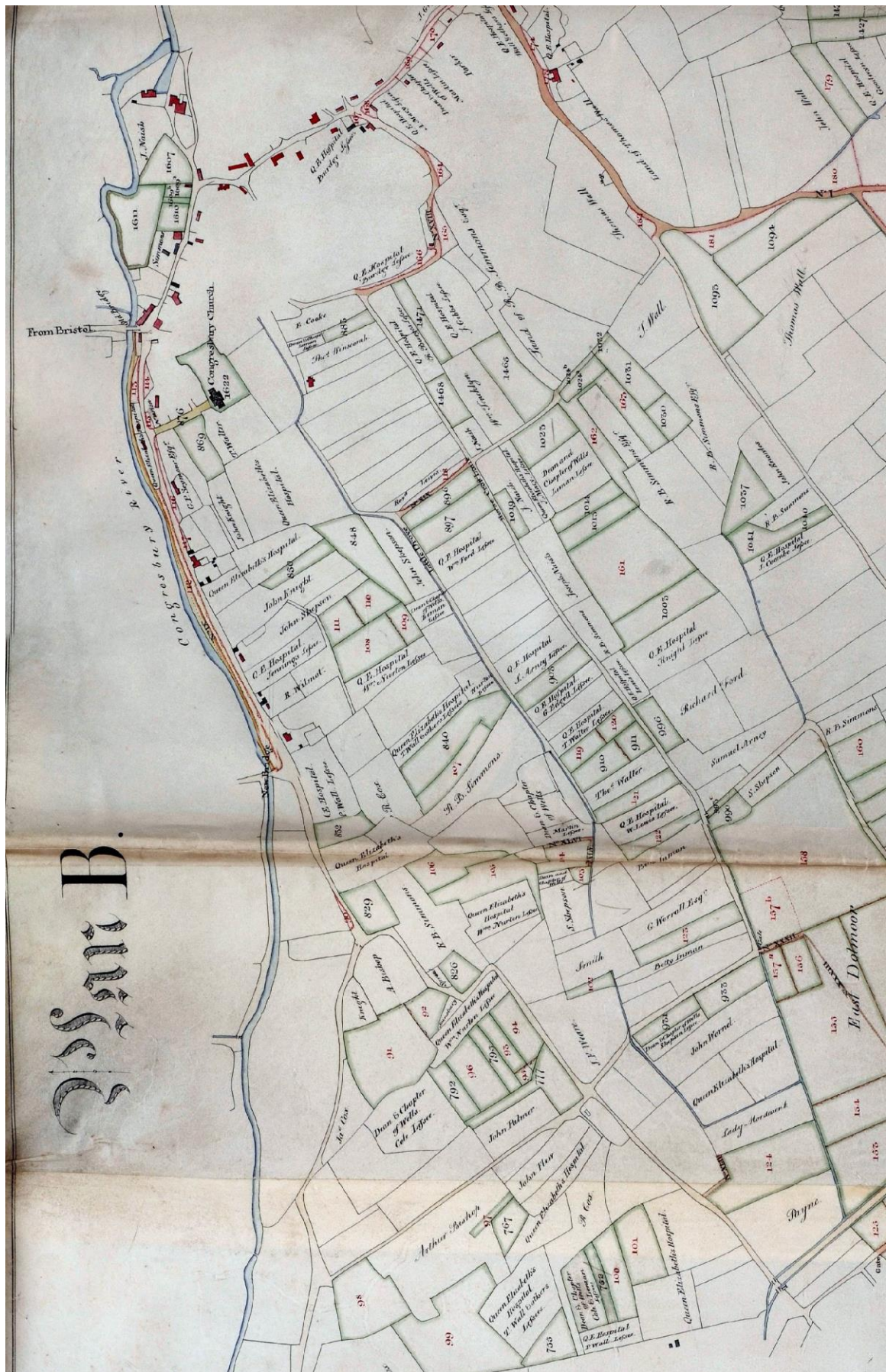
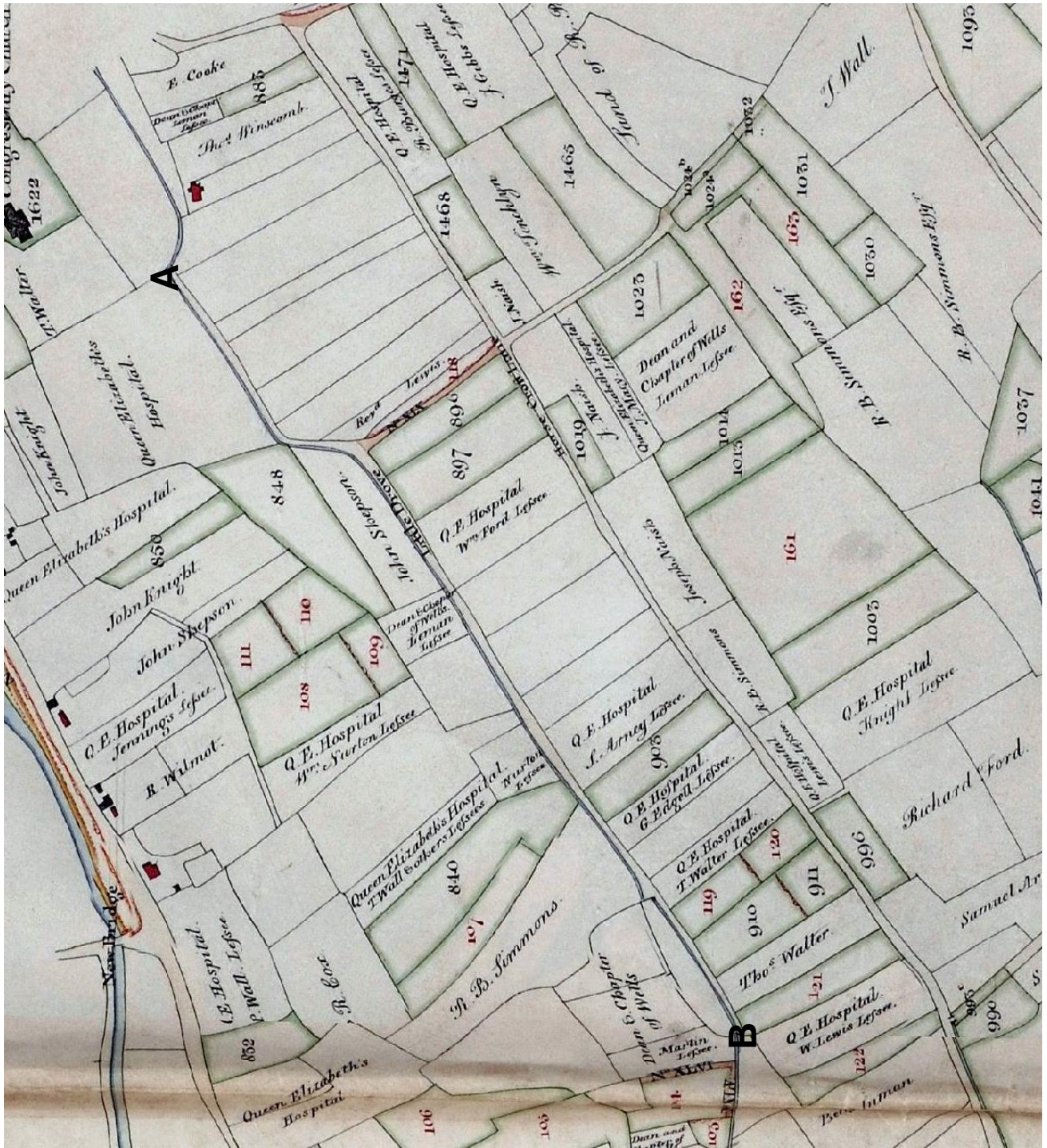

CONGRESBURY, WICK ST LAWRENCE AND PUXTON ENCLOSURE PLAN B 1814



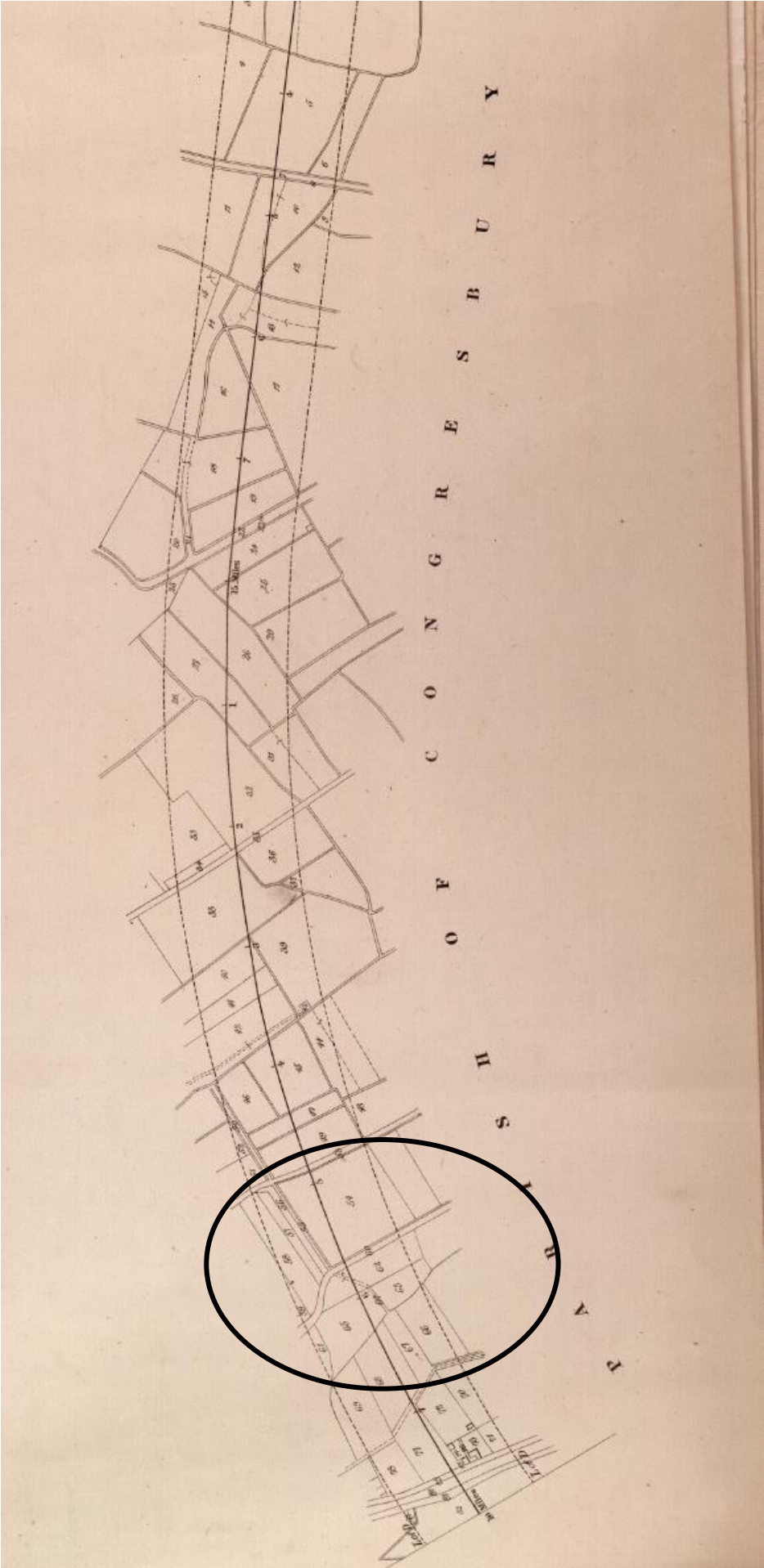
