Additional Third Party comments

Additional condition (10) is recommended in the interests of public safety and to prevent potential damage to the building, to ensure the management and regulation of supply and overflow arrangements of the water storage area beneath the structure is satisfactory.

10. Prior to filling the water storage area/tank with water, details of the water level management, supply and overflow arrangements shall first be submitted to and approved in writing by the Local Planning Authority. The development shall thereafter be carried out in complete accordance with the approved details.

Reason: To reduce the risk of flooding to the development from surface water and in accordance with policy CS3 of the North Somerset Core Strategy policy and policy DM1 of the North Somerset Sites and Policies Plan (Part 1- Development Management Policies).
